Materials:

- Cardboard Paper Rolls
- Colored Craft Sticks (4 1/2 X 3/4 in)
- Cardstock Paper
- Colorful Craft Tape
- Pipe Cleaners
- Glue
- Scissors
- Craft Jewels or gems

Directions:

1. First, cut an empty cardboard tube in half.
2. Trace and cut out a circle from cardstock paper and glue it to one end of the tube making the base of the basket.
3. Cut seven colorful wooden craft sticks in half.
4. Glue the craft stick halves on the cardboard tube.
5. Decorate the basket with the colorful craft tape.
6. Cut 5 inches of pipe cleaner and glue the ends inside the tube to make the handle of the basket.
7. Finally, glue the gems or jewels to the basket to add the finishing touch!

Exciting Easter Snack Ideas

Easter Egg Fruit Pops



Materials: Yogurt, Granola, Blueberries, Strawberries, Silicone Egg Shaped Mold, Cake Pop Sticks

Place a small dollop of yogurt into each egg in your silicone mold, filling each egg about 1/3. Push chunks of granola into the yogurt, then add a few raspberries and blueberries to each egg too. Place a cake pop stick into each compartment, laying it down as flat as possible. Fill each egg to the top with yogurt, making sure it covers all of the fruit and the cake pop stick. Place the mold in the freezer and freeze for at least 2 hours or overnight, until the eggs are frozen through and solid. Once frozen, pop the eggs out of the molds and leave the popsicles on a plate at room temperature for a couple of minutes to soften a little. Enjoy this healthy, sweet and springy treat!

Easter Bunny Faces



Materials: Mini Cheese Circles, Celery Sticks, Baby Carrots, Mini Chocolate Chips

Start by laying out the mini cheese circles on plates. Place two mini chocolate chips on each cheese circle to make the eyes. Cut triangles from the baby carrots to make a nose for each bunny. Place the carrot triangle below the eyes. Cut the celery sticks into very small strips, making sure there is enough for 4 strips per bunny. Place two small celery strips on each side of the carrot nose to make the whiskers. Cut baby carrots in half and place both halves into the top of the cheese circle to make the ears. Enjoy this hip hopping bunny snack!
