Materials:

- Embroidery Thread (Various Spring Colors)
- Water Balloons
- Balloon Pump
- Elmer's Glue
- Water
- Wax Paper
- Tack
- Tweezer



String Easter Eggs

Directions:

1. Start by blowing up some of the water balloons with the balloon pump.
2. Cut the embroidery thread into long pieces, about an arm's length. It should take about 6-8 pieces for each balloon.
3. Mix the Elmer's glue and some water in a bowl until the mixture is just runny enough to soak into the embroidery thread.
4. Take a piece of your thread and dunk it into the bowl with the water glue mixture. Be sure to press it in all the way so that the whole length of the thread gets nice and saturated.
5. Grab an end of the thread and squeeze out the excess liquid between your fingers as you pull it from the bowl.
6. Now wrap it around the balloon, and repeat with each piece of thread until it looks good to you.
7. Place the balloons on wax paper to let them dry for a few hours.
8. Once the thread has dried, use a tack to pop the balloon and remove the popped balloon with tweezers. This should leave your dried thread in an egg shape.
9. To finish, tie another piece of embroidery thread to the top of the egg and hang it up for a special Easter decoration. Enjoy!



Extraordinary Easter Snack Ideas

Easter Bunny Pancakes



Materials: Whole Wheat Pancake Mix, Bananas, Strawberries, Blueberries, String Cheese

Start by making the whole wheat pancakes. For each bunny you will need 3 pancakes, one large about 5 inches in diameter, and two small about 1 1/2 inches in diameter. Place the two small pancakes next to each other on the big pancake. Next, peel a banana and cut it in half to make two ears. Place the ears at the top of the big pancake. Cut three circles from another banana, two of the circles will be eyes. Place the banana eyes on the big pancake above the smaller pancakes. Add a blueberry to each banana eye. Cut the other banana circle in half and create the teeth. Slice a strawberry for the nose. Pull apart the string cheese and add the strips to make the whiskers. Enjoy this fun Easter breakfast!

Hard Boiled Egg Bunny



Materials: Hard Boiled Eggs, Sesame Seeds, Baby Carrots, Rosemary Sprigs

Slice one hard-boiled egg in half vertically. One half will be the bunny's body. Place it on a plate. Slice the other half in half vertically again. These will become the ears. Take another hard-boiled egg and cut it in half horizontally. One half will be the head. Use the remaining half to make two feet and a bunny tail. Place two black sesame seeds on the head for the eyes. Cut a baby carrot into a small triangle and place it for the nose. Put six rosemary sprigs next to the carrot triangle for the whiskers. Decorate the plate with a sliced baby carrot and rosemary sprig. Enjoy this simple Easter snack!
