Handprint Easter
 Chick



Materials:

1. Yellow and White construction paper
2. Scissors
3. Wiggle eyes
4. Orange construction paper
5. Glue stick
6. Yellow feathers

Directions:

- Trace the child's hand onto the yellow paper
- Cut out the out line of their hand
- Using white paper, cut out a broken egg shell
- Glue the egg shell to the front of your handprint
- Glue wiggle eyes and a beak (cut from the orange construction paper) to the front of your hand just above the egg shell
- Glue some yellow feathers to the back side so they poke up behind the hand

Paper Plate Easter Bunny

1. **For the nose:** Take 3 pipe cleaners and twist them around each other in the center so that they are connected/stuck together. Then glue the pipe cleaners to the paper plate. Leave time to let them dry as this step will require the pipe cleaners to be glued well or they may fall off. Once the pipe cleaners are dry, glue on your nose (pom pom).

2. **For the ears:** Cut out some ears from white construction paper and then cut out a smaller inside ear with a different color (pink, yellow, purple ect.) Glue together and glue the ears to the plate.

3. **For the eyes:** Use googly eyes and glued them on. (You can also use construction paper and make the eyes yourself.)

4. **For the mouth:** Draw on the mouth with a black marker.





Snack Ideas for Easter



Hard Boiled Egg Bunny: Slice one hard boiled egg in half lengthwise. One half will be the bunny's body. Place on a plate. Slice the other half in half again. These will become the ears. Take another hard boiled egg and cut it in half horizontally. One half will be the head. Use the remaining half to make two feet and a bunny tail. Decorate the bunny with two black sesame seeds for the eyes, a slice of baby carrot cut into a triangle for the nose, and six rosemary sprigs for the whiskers. Decorate the plate with a sliced baby carrot and rosemary sprig carrot.



Easter Nest Bagels: First split each of the whole grain bagels in half. Pop the bagel halves into the toaster and toast until golden brown. Spread your choice of hummus or cream cheese over the cut side of each bagel half. Cut the carrots into thin straw-like strips. Arrange the carrot strips on top of each bagel half to form nest shapes. Depending on the size of your carrot, you may need to cut some of the strips in half to make this easier. Slice a cucumber and cut egg shapes from cucumber slices. Place three of the cucumber eggs into the center of each bagel nest.
