Giant Paper Towel Roll Butterfly

Materials:

- Construction Paper: Various Colors
- Paper Towel Rolls
- Googly Eyes
- Decorating Supplies: Pom Poms, Buttons, Glitter Glue, Yarn, Stickers
- Colored Craft Sticks
- Glue



Directions:

1. Using the construction paper, cut four wing sections for each butterfly.
2. Tape 2 paper towel rolls together for each butterfly body.
3. Glue 2 popsicle sticks inside the top of the paper towel rolls for the antennae.
4. Glue pom poms to the end of the popsicle sticks.
5. Let the kids paint the paper towel rolls and set them aside to dry.
6. Next, glue the 4 wing pieces together to make the wings of a butterfly.
7. Let the kids decorate the wings using pom poms, glitter glue, buttons, stickers, yarn and anything else you want.
8. To finish the butterfly, glue the paper towel roll body in the middle of the wings and let it dry!

Creepy Crawly Critter Snack Ideas

Materials: Ritz Crackers, Peanut Butter, Pretzel Sticks, Candy Eyes

Start by breaking the pretzel sticks in half. Spread peanut butter on one Ritz cracker. Stick 8 pretzel halves into the peanut butter arranging them to look like spider legs. Spread some peanut butter on a second Ritz Cracker and place on top of the pretzel sticks. Using 2 small drops of peanut butter, stick the candy eyes on the top of the second Ritz Cracker. Enjoy this creepy crawly summer snack!

Materials: Strawberries, Banana, Cream Cheese, Mini Chocolate Chips

Slice the strawberries, and bananas into medium-size slices (leave one strawberry whole). Place the one whole strawberry on a plate. Line the sliced bananas and strawberries behind the large strawberry in a snake like pattern. Add the small tip of the strawberry at the end for a rattle tail. Optional: To make the snake hold together, place small dollops of cream cheese between each piece and press to adhere. Place two dots of cream cheese on the top of the large strawberry head. Put two mini-chocolate chips in the center of the white dots.
