Materials:

- Coffee Filters
- Washable Marker
- Clothespins
- Pipe Cleaners
- Black Sharpie
- Spray Bottle
- Hot Glue



Directions:

1. Start by having the kids color the coffee filters with markers in fun patterns and designs.
2. Spray the colored coffee filters with water until the colors blend.
3. Let the coffee filters dry completely.
4. Using the black sharpie, draw smiley faces on the part of the clothes pins that you push to open.
5. Cut the pipe cleaners into small pieces about 2-3 inches long.
6. Twist two of the small pipe cleaner pieces together at the bottom.
7. Bend both top ends of the pipe cleaners to look like antennae.
8. Twist the middle of a coffee filter and place the clothes pin around the twisted middle.
9. To finish, hot glue the antennae to the top of the clothes pin behind the drawn smiley face.

Bouquet



Materials: Carrots, Cucumber, Green Grapes, Blueberries, Kabob Skewers, Small Flower Cookie Cutters

First, peel the carrots and cucumbers. Next, cut the carrots and cucumbers into thick slices. Shape into flowers using small cookie cutters. To make each flower, first thread a grape onto a skewer. The grape helps to hold the flower in place and stops it from slipping down the skewer. Add one or two of the cucumber and carrot flowers, then top with a blueberry. Make several flower skewers to have a whole bouquet! Enjoy this fun flowery treat!

Peanut Butter Snail



Materials: Apples, Celery Sticks, Peanut Butter, Mini chocolate morsels, Straight Pretzels

Cut each celery stick into thirds. Fill the center of the celery sticks with peanut butter. Carefully break a straight pretzel into small pieces. Insert 2 pretzel pieces next to each other at one end of the piece of celery to resemble antennae. Place 2 mini morsels under the pretzels on each piece of celery to resemble eyes. Slice an apple and cut one of the slices in half. Place the cut side into the peanut butter to make the snail's back. Enjoy!
