- Toilet Paper Rolls

- 7. Glue the feathers to the back of the toilet paper roll.

Thanksgiving Snack Ideas

Crescent Roll Cornucopias



Materials: Whole Wheat Refrigerated Crescent Roll Dough, Foil, Carrot Sticks, Celery Sticks, Cherry Tomatoes, Bell Peppers, Cheddar Cheese Slices, Small Fall Cookie Cutters (Pumpkins and Leaves)

Start by shaping the whole wheat crescent roll dough into a cornucopia. Bake according to the package directions, or until the dough is turning golden in color. Use the cookie cutters to cut the cheese, and peppers into fall shapes. Add these shapes to fill the cornucopia. Place the carrot and celery sticks and the cherry tomatoes in the cornucopia as well. Enjoy this cute and simple Thanksgiving snack!

Cheese and Crackers Pumpkin Pie



Materials: Triscuit Thin Crips, Chicken in a Biskit Crackers, Cream Cheese, Block of Cheddar Cheese,

Cut triangles from the block of cheese to fit on a Triscuit Thin Crisp. Dab a bit of cream cheese on a Triscuit and place the cheddar triangle on top. Dab a little cream cheese on the bottom half of a Chicken in a Biskit cracker and attach to one end of the Triscuit. It doesn't take very much cream cheese to adhere the crackers. Add a tiny dollop of cream cheese on top for "whipped cream." Enjoy this creative way to have classic Thanksgiving dessert as a healthy snack!
