Materials:

- Cardboard
- Black Paint
- Paint Brush
- White Yarn
- Googly Eyes
- Scissors
- Glue Dots
- Tape

Directions:

- 1. Start by drawing a body shape on the cardboard.
- 2. Cut out the cardboard body.
- 3. Paint the front of the cardboard body with the black paint, covering the cardboard completely. Let the paint dry.
- 4. Once the paint is dry, use the glue dots to glue the googly eyes on the head of the mummy.
- 5. Cut small slits along the edge of the body shape to help with the wrapping.
- 6. Tape the end of your white yarn to the back of the cardboard (at the top) and begin wrapping the yarn around the face of the mummy, leaving a space open for the eyes. Continue wrapping the mummy all the way down and wrap each of the arms and legs.
- 7. When you are finished wrapping your mummy craft, tape the end of the yarn onto the back of the mummy.
- 8. Enjoy this cute and spooky Halloween monster craft!

Spooky Spider Rice Cakes



Apple Monster

Materials: Raspberry and Blueberry Rice Cakes, Blackberries, Black Grapes, Clean Paint Brush

Start by crushing a few blackberries in a small bowl with the back of a fork. Using a clean paintbrush, paint a spider web with the blackberry juice on a white plate. Next, cut the rest of the blackberries in half. Place 3 rice cakes on the web, then add a half blackberry spider body on top of each rice cake. Slice the black grapes in half from top to bottom, then slice each half into 4 thin spider legs. Add the legs to your spiders, then eat them up before they scurry away!

Materials: Green Apples, Sunflower Butter, Sunflower Seeds, Strawberries, Candy Eyes

Cut the apples into quarters. Cut the middle out of each quarter of the apple to create a gap for the mouth. Fill the inside of the cut apple with sunflower butter. Place 4 sunflower seeds on the top of the "mouth" for the teeth. Place 1 sliced strawberry inside the mouth for the tongue. "Glue" candy eyes above the mouth with a dab of sunflower butter. Enjoy these frightfully delicious monsters!
