Directions:

1. Start by tearing the tissue paper into small pieces.
2. Paint the outside of the jar using the Mod Podge.
3. Place the pieces of colorful tissue paper on the Mod Podge until the entire jar is covered in color.
4. Cut small trees trunks and limbs out of the brown construction paper.
5. Paint a small area on top of the tissue paper with Mod Podge. Place the brown tree on the Mod Poded area.
6. The final step is to cover any loose ends of the tissue paper with Mod Podge to ensure that they stay.
7. Place a tea light candle inside the jar and enjoy this beautiful and festive fall decoration!

Awesome Autumn Snack Ideas

Materials: Whole Wheat English Muffin, Peanut Butter, Bananas, Strawberries, Blueberries

First cut the English muffin in half and set aside. Slice some of the strawberries into large slices. Cut another strawberry into smaller triangles and slice the bananas. Next, toast the English muffin. Spread peanut butter on the toasted English muffin. Place two banana slices at the top on the peanut butter. Place a blueberry on each banana slice to complete the eyes. Put a small strawberry triangle below the eyes to be the beak. Place two strawberry slices on each side of the muffin to be the wings. Enjoy this cute fall snack!

Autumn Leaf Fruit Salad



Materials: Green Grapes, Red Grapes, Blackberries, Large Clementines, Lemon Juice, Maple Syrup, Cantaloupe, Watermelon

Start by slicing the grapes length wise and place in a large bowl with the blackberries. Peel the clementines and break them into segments. Add the clementines to the bowl. In a separate small bowl, whisk the lemon juice and maple syrup until they are well combined. Pour the juice and syrup mixture over the bowl of fruit and gently mix it all together. Using leaf shape cookie cutters, cut leaves out of the cantaloupe and watermelon. Place the fruit salad into bowls and top with the melon leaves to decorate. Enjoy!
